

If a topic has no clear boundaries, it can become endless and will usually lack focus and depth. Therefore, you should define your research objective as precisely as possible to help manage your time, your sources, and the intended length of your writing assignment. The following criteria are meant to help you narrow down your topic in a sensible and well-founded manner. They can also help you prepare for a consultation with your professor.

<u>In the table below</u>, you can find a general catalogue of criteria in the left column and specific examples of options in the right column that were selected for a writing assignment about "The role of the father in the medical records of chronically ill children".

On the next page, we have provided a blank table that you can fill in with aspects relevant to your own writing assignment. While doing this, you may realize that one aspect sparks your interest in particular, that one might be less relevant for your topic, or that you would like to find out more about something first in order to make a decision. Make a note of these thoughts. You can also highlight the corresponding rows in different colors to make them stand out visually for later reference.
